“Money, Money, Money” is a song by the famous Swedish pop group [ABBA](#), which was incredibly successful in the 1970s. Having gained fame by winning the Eurovision Song Contest in 1974 with [Waterloo](#), the group had a long run of successes. The songs were generally, although not always, joyful and light-hearted, using a musical production technique called the [Wall of Sound](#), that played well on radio and on jukeboxes.

Although their huge success contributed to the break-up of the two couples in the group (Benny Andersson & Anni-Frid Lyngstad and Agnetha Flätskog & Björn Ulvaeus), their music remained popular, especially following the successful musical [Mamma Mia!](#) (the name of another song), which played in theatres worldwide and was made into a [film](#) with Meryl Streep. In 2021, ABBA finally got together again and released a new album ([Voyage](#)).
