II. Washington's and Jefferson's contribution to influencing the US politically until today

<u>-> important to note</u> : the influence of their political ideologies, most of them remaining today, some in the consituion, others observable in the political organisation of the US .

Washington's political ideologies :

 <u>federalism</u>: put in place by G.Washington , still in place and observable today , even if it's form has evolved to a dual approach.

 <u>National Unity</u>: He is the one who highlighted it in the Constitution, and this ideology remains today, stronger than ever (the constitution is a symbol of this national unity as well as many other symbols (flag, anthem..)

<u>Jefferson political influence / ideology</u>

<u>-Jeffersionan Democracy</u>: idea of a direct participation of the people in the poltical process => Still observable today , throught the <u>ex</u> : of referendums.

I.Contribution to America's independence.

<u>-> Main idea</u> : both of Washington and Jefferson, played a key role in achieving independance from 1775 to 1783, on different levels.

<u>Jefferson</u>

 after the war of independance -> writing of the
"Declaration of Independance" -> Jefferson was among the authors -> the one who wrote the core of the declaration : "all men are created equal".
