- Member of a Republican party
- He held several important positions in america (Vice President of the United States 1981 to 1989)
- He served as the 41st President of the United States (1989 to 1993).
- During his presidency, he launched successful military operations against Panama and Iraq (Gulf War)
- He fail to develop economic plan that would erase the recession in 1990.
- George H. W. Bush's approach to federalism was shaped by the political context of his time, and his administration's policies reflected a balance between centralization and devolution

- Member of Republican party as his father
- 43rd President of USA, serving from 2001 to 2009 (he was reelected twice)
- He led the country's response to the September 11 terrorist attacks in 2001
- In response to the 9/11 attacks, he launched an international military campaign called the 'Global War on Terrorism'.
- He is known for his education reformed (Ex: the law "No Child left behind")
- He is credited with improving relations of the United States with several nations, most prominently in Africa, where he launched the Emergency Plan for AIDS relief
- He seemed to have little concern for the values of federalism. Federalism was often subordinated to his policy goals, and where these goals required the centralization of government power, it was vigorously pursued
