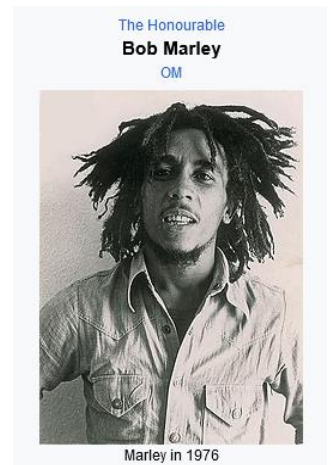


**Bob Marley “Get up, stand up” (Munich, live 1980)**

[According to Wikipedia](#): “Robert Nesta Marley **OM** (6 February 1945 – 11 May 1981) was a Jamaican **reggae** singer, guitarist, and songwriter. Considered one of the pioneers of the genre, his music **fused** elements of reggae, **ska**, and **rocksteady**, and he was **renowned** for his distinctive vocal and songwriting style.<sup>[2][3]</sup> Marley's contribution to music irrefutably increased the visibility of **Jamaican music worldwide**, and made him a global figure in popular culture.<sup>[4][5]</sup> Over the course of his career, Marley became known as a **Rastafarian** icon, and he infused his music with a sense of **spirituality**.<sup>[6]</sup> He is also considered a global symbol of **Jamaican music and culture** and identity, and was controversial in his **outspoken** support for democratic social reforms. He also supported legalisation of **cannabis**, and advocated for **Pan-Africanism**.<sup>[7]</sup> In 1976, Marley survived an **assassination attempt** in his home, which was thought to be politically motivated.<sup>[8]</sup> ” He died of cancer in 1981.
