Mr. Tambourine Man is one of Bob Dylan's famous songs. It was **released** in 1965. The song is about dreams and **imagination**. The music is soft, and the words are beautiful. Songwriter – A person who writes music and words for songs. **Greatest** – Better than all the others.

Harmonica – A small musical instrument played with the mouth. **Lyrics** – The words of a song.

Poetry – Beautiful writing with rhythm and emotion. **Prize** – Something given to a person for doing something great. **Released** – When a song or album is made available to the public. **Imagination** – The power to create pictures or ideas in your mind. **Listener** – A person who hears music or words.

Journey – A long trip from one place to another.
