1) Test 1 (20% of total mark) for 24 October

Also, find one good Internet video (Youtube?) showing this site to the class: it should be about 5 minutes long.

The group will be marked on the quality of its oral presentation — most notably the ability to speak from short notes AND not read a text off a smartphone — and the quality of PPT
