

### Vocabulary – Text on AI and English football

1. **Cutting edge:** highly advanced; innovative or pioneering
2. **Underpin:** support, justify, or form the basis for
3. **In-house:** within the organization (not external)
4. **Visuals:** pictures, videos, or displays used to illustrate or accompany something
5. **Feedback:** helpful information or criticism that is given to someone to say what can be done to improve their work or performance, or a product, etc
6. **At the forefront:** the position of greatest importance or advancement; the leading position in any movement or field
7. **Asset:** a useful or valuable thing or person (accounting: property owned by a person or company)
8. **Harness:** to bring under conditions for effective use
9. **Widen the gap:** a situation where the space between two things, such as people, opinions, or economic resources, gets bigger.
10. **Polar opposite:** two things or two persons who are as different as possible
11. **Take a gamble:** to do something that could produce a (very) bad or unpleasant result
12. **Silver bullet:** a simple and seemingly magical solution to a complicated problem. Often used in the negative (“is not a silver bullet”)
